

Best Way to See the Grand Canyon - White Water Rafting



The Grand Canyon National Park has been one of the most frequently visited tourist locations within The United States. Naturally, hiking is the most popular way of getting familiar with the park. However, there are other options. There are over 150 named rapids within the Canyon; some of them rated as class IV or even V.
