Those who like a bit of royal taste will appreciate a night in a castle - the Danske Slotte og Herregaarde, or Association of Danish Castles and Manor Houses, offers more than 50 properties which possess all the charm and glamour to satisfy even the most demanding guest.

Hotel Fox is also one of the exceptional examples of Danish inspiration and a sense for experiment. For the launch of the new Volkswagen Fox, artists of various skills turned this ordinary building in the center of Copenhagen into the most creative and exciting hotel.
