Mark the sights that are closed for holidays or on specific days. Find out more about festivals and holidays if you're interested in attending them during your trip.

Counting days

Most travelers must fit their trips into available days instead of deciding how much time they need to see everything. Determine how many days you have and make a rough plan where you want to spend them. Consider transport days and your arrival or departure. Take a possible jet lag into account if you will change time zones. Some travelers prefer to spend their time on the beach, while others want to see as many sights as they can. Plan a few major sights per day because they may take a lot of your time. Think about relevant experiences and guess how long they will take.

Choosing bases

Based on how much time you have at your disposal, choose a few items from your group lists. Lay out places and days on your calendar and determine what days you will arrive and leave at every destination. Focus on working hours when it comes to museums and similar places.

Checking transport

Decide how you will get to the desirable places, check available flights, and try to answer these basic questions:

- Can you get direct flights?
- When do they arrive and leave?
- Are there any long layovers to benefit from?
- What about their price?

Getting around
