How much does a tourism graduate earn in the United States in 2023?

According to PagoProfesional, the average annual salary for a tourism graduate in the United States is approximately \$ 37,800. However, this salary can vary substantially depending on position, location, education, and experience.

As your career progresses, you can earn a significantly higher salary. For example, the CEO of a tour company can earn between \$ 62,000 and \$ 80,000 a year. Marketing and sales directors, on the other hand, can earn around \$ 50,000 to \$ 60,000 a year. Senior and general managers can earn between \$ 45,000 and \$ 55,000 annually.
