A minimum of \$10 of each pass sold goes to Cooking with Kids, a non-profit organization. Its basis is working with elementary school children to teach them about healthy life style and good eating habits.

They learn how to prepare affordable food and in today's world, this is a truly inspiring approach. Hopefully, this November will once again attract many visitors who will help local children change their approach to food.
